Language Arts - Students will continue to work on literacy strategies that will help them grow as readers. Some of these strategies consist of making connections, analyzing, synthesizing, and evaluating. We will also be continuing our study of narrative writing. Students will be writing full narrative pieces.

Science - The students will be wrapping up Electricity (5H) and Chemistry (5TJ and 5VB) units this month. The next science unit for all classes is Weather and Climate.

Social Studies- The students are learning about some key events in history that have helped shape our identity today. The main topics of study are immigration, Confederation, Famous 5, Great Depression, and life in Canada during World War I and II.

Health - We will be studying the basic components of the human reproductive system and their functions. Fertilization and conception will also be topics discussed. We will be looking at this unit from a Biblical perspective and our focus will be on honouring God with our bodies. (Classes are on May 8th.) **If you have concerns about your child participating in this discussion, please contact your child's homeroom teacher.**

Math - This month we are finishing up Measurement and starting Patterns and Relations which will focus on using patterns to determine rules and continue patterns as well as pre-algebra skills.

Bible - This month we will continue looking at Jesus' Life and Ministry before examining the Psalms.

Memory work: Students need to pick a passage from the book of Psalms to memorize. It must be parent approved and at least 3 verses long. It should be a passage that the students have not previously memorized. Please have it selected by May 16th.

French: The French 5 students have recently finished designing and describing the exterior of their dream home. Throughout the month of May, they will continue to expand their vocabulary to include the rooms and spaces in their home. At the same time, we will be reviewing prepositions, which will enable the students to explain their floor plan in detail. A quiz on rooms and spaces will be scheduled for the end of May.
