Curriculum

Language Arts: We will explore language through various writing pieces, as well as continue our spelling and reading. The students will be working on various writing activities which will include poetry and persuasive writing.

Math: The students are wrapping up their study of Patterns and Relations. The final math unit will be a study of geometry. Reviewing problem solving and basic facts will continue until the end of the year.

Social Studies- We are exploring how events such as The Railway, WW1, the Great Depression and WW2 shaped Canadian Identity. We are also exploring how some individuals have helped shape Canadian identity.

Science – Exploring Weather and Climate is the focus for June. We encourage students to go online daily and read the daily forecast for our city.

Bible: Our focus continues to be studying the life of Jesus as well as looking at various Psalms. Students will be writing their own psalms.

French - The French 5 students are continuing their study of "Ma maison" (My House). They have already designed and described their house exterior and floor plan. Vocabulary will now expand to include furniture and design elements, which will enable the students to share the plans for their dream room in detail.



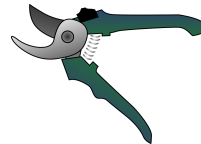
